

Education Credentials Obtained Outside the U.S.

Applicants for research trainee positions at MD Anderson must submit a credential evaluation prior to the extension of an offer if they are using degrees or education credentials obtained outside the United States to meet the minimum education requirement for the position of consideration.

The evaluating company must provide the following:

For Postdoctoral Fellows/Research Interns:

- a certified translation of your diploma, if not in English;
- verification of accreditation of the foreign university;
- the equivalency of non-U.S. degree(s) to a U.S. degree(s);
- verification of your attendance at and graduation from that university

For Student Appointments:

- to confirm the U.S. academic program/level equivalency
- verification of current enrollment

The credential evaluation must be emailed directly from the credentialing company to RTP-EAS@mdanderson.org.

Our office requires a General Credential Evaluation. Any expense to obtain this evaluation will be the responsibility of the candidate.
